Step 1: Our Aim (Our Goal)

“To continuously improve the efficiency of our energy provision and use whilst focused on achieving net zero carbon emissions ahead of 2050”



Step 2: Strategy/Objectives

1. Eliminate our reliance on fossil fuel energy sources for Heating and Power;
2. Maximise our use of renewable energy sources;
3. Significantly reduce waste in all areas of our operations;
4. Share learnings and experience with other similar external organisations;
5. Keep abreast of UK Gov targets, initiatives and take advantage of all available opportunities;
6. Demonstrate carbon emissions reduction on our journey to net zero;
7. Remain agile and flexible to change;
8. Reduce Costs.

Step 3: Plan Development

In developing our plan, we will need to consider the following:

- Each Objective to have Targets with outline timescales;
- Timescales and Targets to be cognisant of risk and opportunities;
- Initial focus to be on areas already under discussion;
- Measures developed to demonstrate progress and achievements;
- Communication and visibility of progress and successes;
- Workload sharing amongst committee members, as far as reasonably possible.
